

Patient Information -> Visiting the Cardiologist

The Pediatric Cardiology Medical Group – East Bay currently operates two full service outpatient offices, one in Oakland (appointments every day) and one in Walnut Creek (appointments three days a week). A third full service office is scheduled to open later this year in Pleasanton where currently patients are seen a few days each month. Ultimately, the Pleasanton office will also accommodate outpatient appointments three days each week. As indicated below, the cardiologists are available on a regular basis in several other locations scattered through the East and North Bay.

Depending on the reason for your child's visit, an EKG, chest x-ray or echocardiogram might be performed just before your child sees the cardiologist. All of these services are performed in or near the exam room where your child will see the cardiologist and the cardiologist will have access to the results of the study (ies) for review with you. The cardiologist may recommend an additional study, e.g. MRI or stress test, or procedure, e.g. cardiac catheterization, and these services will be coordinated with you and your child's pediatrician and scheduled at Children's Hospital Research Center Oakland.

In addition to Oakland, Walnut Creek and Pleasanton, the cardiologists rely on portable EKG and echocardiography machines to provide comprehensive pediatric cardiology evaluations in::

- * Brentwood: One day a month
- * Fremont: One day a month
- * Larkspur: Every Friday afternoon
- * Sonora: One day a month
- * Berkeley (Adult Congenital Heart Disease Only): One day a month
